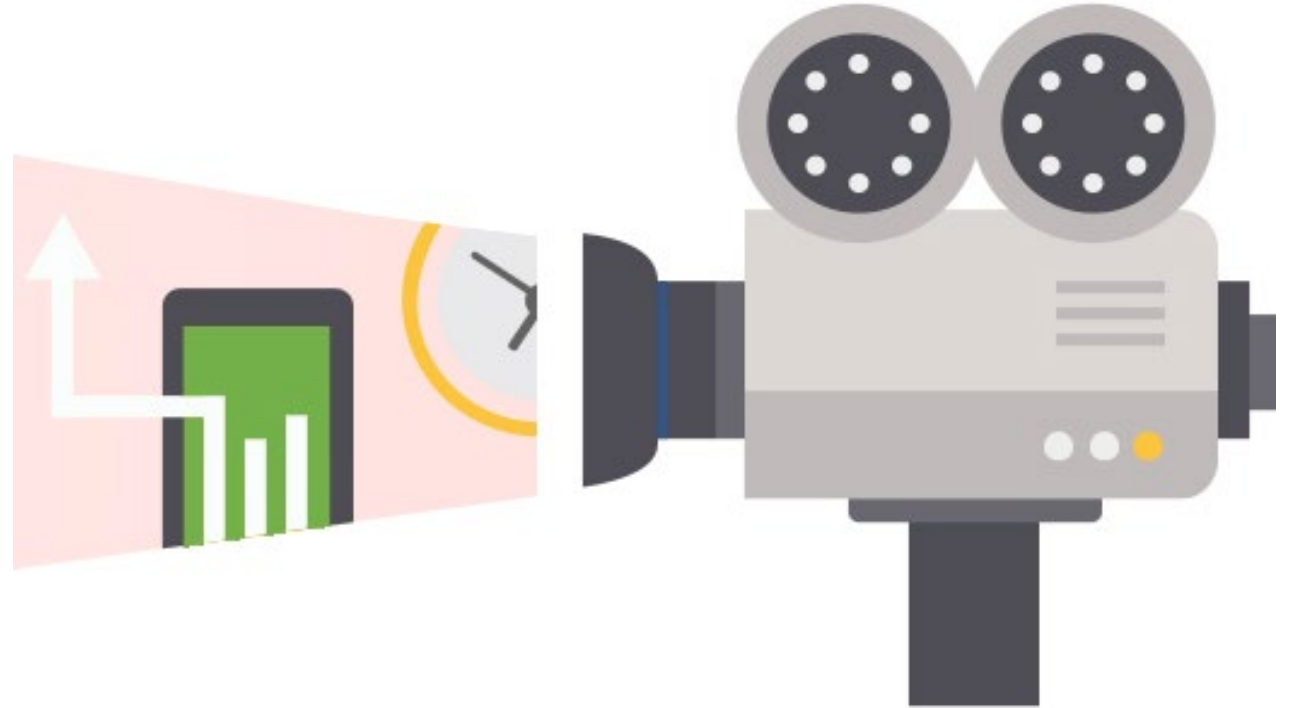
WHAT IS THE RECRUITING TIMELINE ?

Use same face pic on social accounts so coaches recognize you.

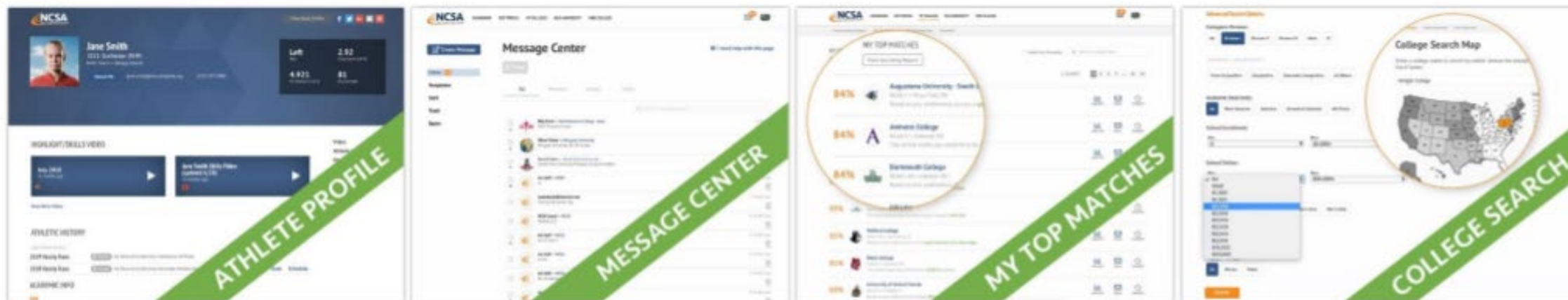
Use handle close to real name so you are easier to find.
