

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (#18) BETWEEN
PETALUMA CITY (ELEMENTARY) AND JOINT UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICTS
AND
PETALUMA FEDERATION OF TEACHERS**

The Petaluma City Schools District ("District") and The Petaluma Federation of Teachers ("PFT"), hereinafter referred to as "the parties," agree to the following Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") regarding additional work performed by the school psychologists to support ERMHS Counseling Coverage.


Due to a leave of absence for a District mental health provider for ERMHS Counseling, the District needs additional support serving students associated with the ERMHS counseling grant from August 16, 2022 through October 11, 2022. School Psychologists willing to support additional students would be paid \$500/student for serving students between these dates.

Duties to serve these students would include:

- Weekly sessions
- Weekly session documentation
- Coordination of IEP meetings
- Attending IEP meetings
- Progress notes
- Medi-cal entry

This MOU is non-precedent setting.
