

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PETALUMA CITY ELEMENTARY AND PETALUMA JOINT UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICTS ("PETALUMA CITY SCHOOLS") DECLARING THE MONTH OF MARCH AS WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH

WHEREAS, the origin of Women's History Month dates back to 1978 in Santa Rosa, California, when the Education Task Force of the Sonoma County Commission on the Status of Women planned a "Women's History Week" celebration during the week of March 8th to correspond with International Women's Day; and

WHEREAS, Women's History Month is celebrated in March to highlight the contributions of women throughout history; and

WHEREAS, women of all backgrounds and identities have served as leaders of every major social change movement, including civil rights movements, labor movements, and LGBTQIA+ movements; and

WHEREAS, women have played a unique role throughout American history by providing the majority of the volunteer labor force and and being key to the establishment of many philanthropic, educational, and cultural institutions; and

WHEREAS, despite these contributions, the impact of women leaders has been consistently overlooked in media, history books, and academic curriculum; and

WHEREAS, The Petaluma City Schools Board of Education recognizes that all students need opportunities to understand the common humanity underlying all people; and

WHEREAS, the Petaluma City Schools Board of Education is committed to enhancing equity, inclusion, and diversity in curriculum and remains dedicated to providing schools with resources and supports to effectively implement the History Social-Science standards and build civic engagement amongst students; now,

THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED**, that Petaluma City (Elementary) and Petaluma Joint Union High School Districts Board of Education does hereby recognize the month of March as Women's History Month.
